Come and celebrate all the good things in life, together with the era of Heritage Trains.

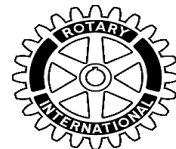
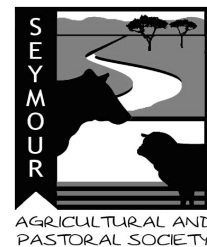
Held over the same weekend as the Seymour Racing Cup.

## Site Details

In 2011 Exhibitor sites will be in Station Street and the grass reserve area between Crawford & Henry Street. Exhibitors are encouraged to improve their site with good signage, brochures and displays.

Each site will be required to bring or hire from us a trestle table.

We are encouraging you to supply market umbrellas badged to promote any regional businesses as this adds to the ambience. Marquees will be used to provide adequate cover for exhibitors. Marquee hire is available or you may bring your own but weights must be used (not ground pegs) as your marquee could be positioned on paths or roadways.

## Liquor Tasting and Sales

We will be selling a Tastes of the Goulburn tasting glass for \$15 or a \$5 tasting tag on last years glass. Each Winery will be required to hold a temporary limited liquor licence for the day; you will need to send a copy of this to us when applying for your site. (see attachment with the details you need to have on your temporary liquor licence application.)

Wineries are able to provide both wine tasting and sales per glass or bottle. **(Only TOTG glasses to be used for consumption of wines at this event)**

The number of Winery Exhibitors will be limited to guarantee a continued successful event. The participants from 2010 will have first option and will need to respond immediately to secure site booking.

## Safety and Security

Volunteer members of the SES and the Seymour Service Clubs will be available to assist in public awareness and safety.

First Aid Service have been enlisted for the day. The organisers accept no responsibility for any loss or damage which may occur to persons or property at the *Tastes of the Goulburn*. Site holders must take all precautions relating to the security of their stock and cash

## Stallholder Public Liability Insurance

**Winery Exhibitors:** Are to have an extension of their own public liability policy to cover their activities at the *Tastes of the Goulburn*. Your certificate of currency is to be available on site.

**Art Craft, Produce and Food Exhibitors:** Site fee includes stallholder public liability (exclusions do apply); if stallholders hold their own insurance, please provide a certificate of currency with the application.

## Food Handlers and Health and Safety

Exhibitors are to comply with the Health and Safety Acts and local regulations. Exhibitors must:

- Hold and display a Registered Food Licence and a Victorian Food Handlers Certificate or obtain a Temporary Food Stall Permit (permit link [www.mitchellshire.vic.gov.au](http://www.mitchellshire.vic.gov.au)).
- Portable fire extinguisher compulsory for those using cooking equipment
- Use of Gas - please be aware and follow the code of practice for the safe use of LPGas at Public Events and use certified gas products (check list will be forwarded to you) - see Energy Safe Victoria Web site :- [www.esv.vic.gov.au/LinkClick.aspx?fileticket=3ntw0Lsaefg%3D&tabid=36&mid=1351](http://www.esv.vic.gov.au/LinkClick.aspx?fileticket=3ntw0Lsaefg%3D&tabid=36&mid=1351)
- Each site must have hand washing facilities: plastic basin / bucket with soap / disinfectant solution and hand towels. Water is available from the restrooms.

Site access will be from 7.30am . All vehicles must be parked away from Station Street by 9am for the advertised commencement of 10am. Advertised completion time is 4pm. Site exhibitors must be available until this time.
